- Session proposals must include **at least 4** unique paper presenters. **At least 50 percent of all presenters in a session must be Ph.D. students.** Please indicate this **clearly** in your proposal.

- Session Organizers/Chairs are responsible for allocating presentation time, facilitating Q&A/discussion, coordinating advance distribution of paper drafts (if desired), and the use of a laptop computer or tablet for projection.
